# Prepositions of time Part 1



**Preposition** that allows you to discuss a specific time period such as a date on the calendar, one of the days of the week, or the actual time something takes place.

### <u>At</u>

This preposition of time is used to discuss clock times, holidays and festivals, and other very specific time frames including exceptions, such as "at night."

#### Specific time of the day

at dawn at night, at midday

There was a loud noise which woke us up at midnight.

I always watch the News at breakfast time.

#### **Clock times**

at 6 o'clock,

at 7 p.m., at 18 hrs.

Lucy is arriving on February the 13th at 5 o'clock in the evening.

The train leaves \_ tomorrow morning at 10 am

#### **Festive seasons**

at Christmas at Easter

Do you usually eat chocolate eggs at Easter?

I usually go to my parents' house at Christmas. We eat turkey together on Christmas Day.

#### **Seasons**

in summer

in the summer

The trees here are really beautiful in the spring.

They usually go to the south of France in the summer.



This preposition of time is used to discuss months, seasons, years, centuries,

general times of day, and

longer periods of time such as "in the past."

#### Parts of the day

in the morning

in the afternoon, in the evening

I like to drink coffee in the morning and tea in the evening I often get sleepy in the afternoon.

#### **Months**

in July,

in August, in the month of August

The weather is often terrible in London in January His birthday is in June.

#### **Years**

in 1996,

in 2023, in the year 2023

Shakespeare died in 1616

I graduated from university in 2010

#### **Seasons**

in summer

in the summer

The trees here are really beautiful in the spring.

They usually go to the south of France in the summer.

## <u>On</u>

This preposition of time is used to discuss certain days of the week or portions of days of the week, specific dates, and special days such as "on New Year's Day."

#### **Days**

on Sunday, on Sundays
on Good Friday
on my birthday

I like to drink coffee in the morning and tea in the evening I often get sleepy in the afternoon.

# Dateson the 25th of Decemberon December 25th

The weather is often terrible in London in January His birthday is in June.
